I. MAP IMPLEMENTATION OVERVIEW

1. This Management Progress Report constitutes the International Finance Corporation's (IFC) update on implementation of the Management Action Plan (MAP) in response to the CAO Compliance Investigation Report on the complaint (the Complaint)¹ concerning Alto Maipo (Project No. 31632) (the Project). Alto Maipo is a hydropower project in Chile. IFC exited its participation in May 2018 and the project is no longer active.

A. MAP Implementation Status

2. Alto Maipo is now operational, and construction was completed by the end of 2021. Therefore, most of the actions in the MAP, disclosed in September 2021, focused on additional document disclosure and internal IFC actions rather than specific Project undertakings. The progress of MAP implementation is fully completed. Externally facing activities, such as: (i) the disclosure of relevant Environmental and Social Impact Assessment (ESIA)-related documentation on the IFC project disclosure website²; (ii) engagement with Itaú Corpbanca, other financiers, Alto Maipo and US-based AES Corporation to share the CAO Report and conclusions with stakeholders; and as required by the CAO Policy direct engagement with the Center for International Environmental Law (CIEL), the Civil Society Organization (CSO) who assisted in filing the Complaint (including Spanish translation and disclosure of the IFC Management Response Executive Summary and MAP), were completed shortly after the Board's approval of the IFC MAP. These actions were all completed by August 2022, with no further inquiries or follow up actions required by external stakeholders.

3. Internal activities including: (iv) enhancement of the Broad Community Support Matrix and BCS disclosure procedures and (v) enhancement of IFC's disclosure system, have also already been implemented, as detailed in the attached table and (vi) guidance on monitoring for ambient air quality has been developed and disseminated among CEG specialists.

B. Conclusion

4. All MAP requirements have been fulfilled and engagement with the CSO as per CAO Policy has been completed. It is therefore expected that the MAP process for this project can be closed.
