The Cradle of Life has also now come in conflict with its own funding and we write this letter to you to stop this madness before more damage happens.

We also notice that Tsodilo has no policy in far as Corporate Social Responsibility, code of conduct and ethics or any corporate governance as yet. We are also concerned about a massive conflict of interest that we picked up between the source of the sou
